

Library Online Catalog:

To search for books available in the high school library:

1. Go to the Somerset Berkley High School website: www.somersetberkeley.org
2. Scroll down to “Library” (click <http://www.somersetberkeley.org/library.html>)
3. Click on “SAILS Library Network e-Catalog”. It should default to searching in “Somerset Berkley High School”. If not, change “everything” to “Somerset Berkley High School” to search our school library collection. You can search by keyword, title, author, subject or series. To search for a book outside of the school library, change “Somerset Berkley High School” to “everything”.



4. To reserve a book from another SAILS library, please ask at the desk for your student ID and pin #. **PLEASE NOTE: During the 2020-21 school year, you can reserve books from other public libraries; however, you need to make arrangements to pick the book up at that library. There is no delivery service this year.**

To search databases for articles and other reference materials:

Follow steps 1 – 3 above

Infotrac: a collection of periodicals, e-Reference books, & multimedia

Proquest : online news article search

JSTOR: includes journals, primary sources and books. No user name & password are needed when JSTOR is used in school. **When accessing JSTOR from home, the username is: somersetberkeley and the password is: researcher**
