## Graduation Time (FAQ)...

Excitement is in the air and we are hoping for an outside graduation. The decision will be made by the final practice which is on Friday morning. There are no tickets needed for the graduation even if it is inside. These tickets will be given to the students at the final practice on Friday morning.

Our gates will be open at 4pm. Parking will be at a premium. The ceremony will begin promptly at 5pm with the entrance march onto the field. (Tip: We are set up alphabetically. Ask your graduate what half they are sitting on to get a great photo op as they march in.) For the safety and comfort of all spectators in the stands, we kindly ask that all noise makers, including air-horns, be left at home for your own personal enjoyment and merriment. At the end of the ceremony, the graduates will be exiting the field near the concession stand. The public will not be able to enter the field. (Tip: Plan a meeting place to gather after the ceremony.) Our anticipation is that the ceremony will conclude about 6:30-7:00pm.

## Senior Info...

We are almost there. There are few things that we need. Make sure that all of your financial obligations are taken care of. Make sure all library and text books are turned in. We will be collecting your Chromebooks on Thursday June 7<sup>th</sup> at graduation practice. If you have lost your Chromebook, it is \$200 to replace it.
