## FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Parents/Guardians who register their child for a class in the 2018 Kids Summer Learning Center are responsible for payment of the tuition fee for that particular class. Tuition fees may vary according to the class registered for.

A student is not considered to be registered/enrolled in the program until payment has been received for that class. The first and second class that a student is registered for are full tuition. Any and all classes after the second class will be eligible for a 20% discount on these classes only. This 20% discount will apply to any one student or to any two or more students in the same household.
